Past Business:    Captain Silver commented that the previous years training went very well and no new comments were noted.

Current Cycle:    Captain Silver Commented that all departments were in compliance with the 2005-2007 training cycle and that the current focus was on the 2007-2009. No comments from the Board

Captain Silver commented that the 2007-2009 training cycle was underway and that all departments seemed to be on track with their officers and that classes were being scheduled, mandated and otherwise that would assist these agencies were currently either being taught, scheduled or have been discussed. Mr Puig commented that the numbers noted as far as officers instructed looked impressive. Member Lockard agreed.

Captain Silver Commented that general compliance seemed in order for all departments if training stayed on track. Member Puig and Lockard seemed very pleased.

Captain Silver commented that the 3232/3939 classes that are mandatory were on track and being taught to fit the needs of the member agencies. Crisis Intervention was discussed and Captain Silver Stated that a large class was already completed and more would be scheduled to fit the needs of the respective departments.

Captain Silver Commented that Tactical classes were ongoing with the Departments SRT and that Harris County SO was also involved in the training which increased the student population.

Captain Silver commented that in June, he would be instructing a block of certification on AED/CPR/Blood borne Pathogens. Member Lockard was very vocal on this point and she and Member Puig were very agreeable to this type of training.

Pass/Fail: Captain Silver commented that in the past, very few pass/fail issues had come up. However, he also commented that with the upcoming medical training, this could be an issue and remediation would prevail with American Heart guidelines guiding that remediation. Members Lockard and Puig agreed.

Student Assist: Captain Silver commented that all remediation at this point was AHA provided

Evals: Captain Silver commented that evaluations of previous classes were very positive especially the new training facility.

Comments: Captain Silver commented that when the contract was to be renewed for the CoOp, the new training facility of 9009 Ruland would be used as the new CoOp address. Members Lockard and Puig agreed.
